

## APPOINTED DIRECTOR CONFIRMATION

The College Board is made up of six elected member directors and three appointed non-member directors.

The Board has two board committees, being the Audit and Risk Committee and the Nomination and Selection Committee. The Nomination and Selection Committee ensures the College has a balanced and appropriately skilled board of directors to deliver a strong and successful College for members.

The Nomination and Selection Committee comprises:

- Mark McCoy (chair) experienced company director and governance expert
- Dr Philip Bachelor former PA community representative director, experienced company director and not for profit chief executive
- Peter Lang College member, paramedic educator, former ANZCP director with over 10 years' service on its board
- Liz Schenke human resources expert

Early this year, the Nomination and Selection Committee undertook a review of the skills of the existing board of directors and, with the board, identified the ideal mix of skills required on the board. This saw the creation of a skills matrix with identified skills required of the directors, e.g., strategy, policy development, risk, governance etc. The skills matrix highlights the skills required of directors individually and collectively for successful leadership of the College.

Under the College Constitution, all director nominations go through a consistent review process undertaken by the Nomination and Selection Committee to ensure they meet the skills requirements of the board.

In April and May, the Nomination and Selection Committee undertook a recruitment process to fill the thee (3) non-member Appointed Director roles. A high quality field of 30 candidates applied with the Committee identifying the best three candidates, who were subsequently appointed to the Board in July by the existing member Directors.

The Corporations Act requires the confirmation of all Director appointments at the next AGM following the appointment. Therefore, the three appointed Directors are put before the members for confirmation at the October 2020 AGM.
