

## Advisory Committee Terms of Reference

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The Terms of Reference for the Advisory Committee are:

- Advise on clinical practice and systemic issues relating to palliative and end-of-life care, and the implications of these for ELLC's activities.
- Provide strategic advice on:
  - Content and format of online training and workshops;
  - Promoting uptake and implementation of the online training, workshops and resources by target groups;
  - Promoting involvement of key stakeholders, and dissemination of project information; and
  - Enhancing sustainability of the Project outcomes.
- Provide other input as required, to support the achievement of the project objectives:
  1. Improve knowledge and awareness of end-of-life law throughout the palliative, health and medical sectors, and community.
  2. Improve access to information about end-of-life law for clinicians across the palliative care, health and medical sectors nationally.
  3. As a result of 1 and 2 above, enhance clinicians' knowledge of the law at end-of-life to:
    - Improve their capacity to manage legal issues arising in the clinical palliative care setting and at the end-of-life.
    - Increase their understanding of advance care planning and address current identified barriers to that planning.
    - Improve service delivery in the community and acute care settings.
