Who are we?

Search and Rescue Services Limited (SRS) operate 8 Bases with a fleet of 10 BK 117's and one H145 T2 covering the Central and Southern North Island of New Zealand. You will join a whānau family of enthusiastic and experienced Pilots, Crewmen and Critical Care Flight Paramedics who provide an essential life-saving service to our local communities.

Our role encompasses providing the highest level of clinical care to many of our most vulnerable communities within Aotearoa | New Zealand, and as such we are committed to the principles of the Treaty of Waitangi and improving health equity and access particularly for the many Māori communities we serve.

As a dedicated government contracted EMS Helicopter provider, we operate on a 24/7, 365-day basis. Flexibility is needed to meet this requirement and you will have to commit to working both 24-hour shifts (on an on-call basis) and 12 hour shifts on-site.

Ko wai mātou?

Ko 'Ratonga Rapu kia Rauora' mātou, ā ka whakahaeretia e 8 ngā pokapū, kotahi 10 ngā toparere BK 117 me tētehi atu toparere H145T2 kia taea ai te toro atu ki te waengapū me te taha tonga o Te Ika-ā-Māui. Ka hono koe ki tētehi whānau rikarika, tokomaha ngā paerata mātanga, he ringa pūkenga, he manapou hoki hai whakarauora i ngā hapori. Ko tā mātou mahi he haumanu i ngā hapori paraheahea o roto o Aotearoa, ka mutu e ū ana mātou ki ngā mātāpono o Te Tiriti o Waitangi, kia whakapai ai te hauora o ngā hapori Māori huri noa. Ka mutu kia whakaōrite ai te mana taurite ki ngā ratonga hauora.

Nā te mea he ratonga toparere mā te kāwanatanga, ka mahia ngā mahi i ngā haora e 24 o ngā rā e 7 o te wiki, mō ngā rā e 365 o te tau. E tika ana kia pīngore te tangata e tutuki ai te haepapae, nā reira me ngākau titikaha koe kia mahia mō te 24 haora [he mahi ā-karanga], kia mahia hoki mō te 12 haora i te wāhi mahi.

The Role

Do you currently hold the Bachelor of Health Science in Paramedicine and are you looking for a new challenge? Have you considered a career with Search & Rescue Services Ltd as a Crewman/Paramedic?



If selected you will be required to undertake an initial 2-day assessment, and if successful you will be offered an intern crewman position for up to twelve months. After successful completion of the internship, you will be an SRSL qualified Crewman able to undertake the following tasks:

- Non-flying Pilot assist as required
- Confined space landing clearances
- Night flying wearing Night Vision Googles (NVGs)
- Day/Night/water winch operator
- Gain an ATP as a Paramedic
- Provide clinical support to our Critical Care Flight Paramedics

This is a challenging and diverse role that provides not only clinical support but will have you operating as an integral part of the aviation team.

The paramedic/crewman internship will focus totally on becoming an aviation crewman for the first 12 months, after which you will be provided further paramedic development/upskilling. As a paramedic/crewman with SRSL you will also be provided with future development opportunities, including within the medical field if you wish to head towards your Post Grad studies, once you have completed a minimum of two years in the crewman role. We have positions available across several of our bases and these vacancies will be discussed with you at the time of acceptance.

Te Tūnga

Mehemea he Tohu Mātauranga Hauroa Ohotata tāu, ka mutu e rapu ana i tētehi whakapātaritari hou? Kua whakaaroa e koe kia mahia mō 'Rapu kia Rauora' hei Kaimahi/Pou Ohotata? Mehemea ka whiria koe, me whakamātau mō te rua rā, ki te puta te ihu ka tukua koe kia tū hei kaimahi, ki te eke anō koe ka whakaritehia he tūnga tauira māu mō te tekau mā rua marama te roa.

Kia oti pai i a koe taua tauira mahi, ka eke ai koe ki te tūnga SRSL tohu kaimahi e taea ana hoki te whakamahi i ēnei mahi:

- He paerata rere-kore
- He kaiwhakatau i te wāhi whāiti
- He rere ā-pō me te mau mōhiti mata pō [NVGs]
- Rā/Pō/he kaiwhakahaere waka hiki wai
- Kia tutuki i a koe he ATP hei Pou Ohotata
- Kia taunaki ā-haumanu i te hunga manapou rauora

He tūnga whakapātaritari, kanorau hoki kia taunaki ā-haumanu koe nōu e mahi tahi ana i te tira rererangi. Ko te mahi i te tīmatanga he kotahi tau te roa, kia taunga koe ki te mahi a te tira haumanu, mō muri ake ka whakapakaritia ō pūkenga pou ohotata. Kia whakapakaritia te tohu SRSL ka tū he akoranga māu e whakawhānui ai ō wheako tae atu ki te wāhangā rongoā e whāia ai hei tohu mātauranga tuarua, engari me oti i a koe te mahi mō te rua tau i te tuatahi. He tūnga e wātea ana huri noa i tō mātau rohe, nā reira he kaupapa e kōrero tahi ai hei te wā ka whakaāetia e koe kia mahi ki konei.

Ko tā te 'Ratonga Rapu kia Rauora' he tiaki pai i te hunga tūroro me ngā whānau kia tōmua ai tōna haumaru, e whakapono ai hoki rātou kāore he tiakitanga i tua atu huri noa i Aoteaora. E ū ana mātou ki Te Tiriti o Waitangi, ki te kanorau ā-ahurea, ki te urutanga ūrite. Whakatenatena ai kia whiwhi tono i te hunga nō wāhi kē, nō ahurea kē. Ka aro atu ki ngā mahi kua mahia, ki ngā tohu mātauranga kua whakawhiwhia, ka mutu e whakapono ana mātau ko te mea nui o tēnei ao, ko te tangata me ūna tini āhuatanga, nā reira ka aro ki te angatakitahi me tana kete wheako. Ka whakamiha atu ki te mana o ia tangata ahakoa nō hea nā runga i te whakapono he painga o roto o te tini tiro atu ki te ao, ka mutu he pērā hoki te haporo, he hapori kanorau.
